

121-14 ANIMALS ON CAMPUS—PROCEDURE

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to regulate the presence of animals and pets on College-owned or controlled property.

2. PROCEDURE

1. Only service or assistance animals, meeting criteria of the Americans with Disabilities Act and approved by the Disability Resources Coordinator will be allowed inside buildings. All exceptions must be authorized by the Security Supervisor or designee.
2. Owners/handlers of animals and pets must properly clean up after, maintain the welfare of, and control the behavior of the animal or pet to ensure compliance with state laws, county, and local ordinances.
3. All animals or pets on any CCC campus must be physically restrained by one of the following: a leash no longer than six (6) feet, secured in a vehicle, cage, or similar enclosure, such that persons in proximity are safe and free from disturbance. Violations will result in the animal being prohibited on campus and may result in disciplinary action under the appropriate code of conduct.
