

**121-15 CONVICTED/REGISTERED SEX OFFENDER CAMPUS
NOTIFICATION—PROCEDURE**

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to promote and contribute to the safety and welfare of the College community through timely and appropriate notification of the presence of any registered sex offender who may be on or live within a one-mile radius of any CCC campus.

2. PROCEDURE

1. Arizona Revised Statutes §13-3821 requires convicted sex offenders to register with the Sheriff in the county where he or she resides. Subsection M of that statute states a sex offender who is a student at a college, who is employed by a college, who volunteers at a college, or who carries on a vocation at a college is required to register this information with the Sheriff in the county where the College is located.
2. The CCC Security Department is responsible for the Operational Manual associated with this procedure and will notify the College community according to the classification system used by the State, the Coconino County Sheriff's Department, and/or any other local law enforcement agency who makes these notifications.
