

303-08 COMMUNITY AND CORPORATE LEARNING—PROCEDURE

1. PURPOSE

Community and Corporate Learning (CCL) endeavors to make available any training necessary for community members to succeed. By providing a “one-stop shop” for learning enhancement, accessibility of knowledge is increased which, in turn, heightens the aggregate social and human capital of the region.

2. PROCEDURE

1. Courses within CCL are specific in nature and may vary in credit, CEU, or non-credit value depending upon the requirements of the discipline.
2. CCL courses will carry their own fee and district-wide revenue is to be deposited into the CCL revenue account to contribute to CCL’s objective of becoming a self-sustaining program.
3. Corporate Contracts
Perform needs assessment for local company, market, collaborate with stakeholders for subsidies, develop curriculum, class delivery, and academic evaluation of program outcomes.
