A. Identification:

1. Subject Area: German
2. Course Number: 128
3. Course Title: German for Travelers
4. Credit Hrs: 2
5. Catalog Description A short course for students who have little or no prior experience with German and need specific vocabulary and cultural information for their anticipated adventures in traveling to countries where German is used. Two lecture. May be taken for S/U credit.

B. Course Goals: To learn specific travel vocabulary in German and practice role-play situations for given cultural scenarios and travel situations.

C. Course Outcomes:

Students will:

1. Understand vocabulary and sentence structure sufficient to communicate basic information.
2. Create simple statements in German.
3. Demonstrate knowledge to obtain necessary information.
4. Demonstrate an awareness of cultural aspects and ways to interact.

D. Course Content:

Will include:

1. Alphabet
2. Numbers, phone directories
3. Time and dates
4. Greetings, common courtesy formulae.
5. Travel vocabulary for the airport, taxi, hotel, restaurant, tourist sites.
6. Gestures, what to say, what (what not) to wear, what (what not) to do in a legal situation
