1. Subject Area: Military Science (MSC)
2. Course Number: 102
3. Course Title: Basic Leadership
4. Credit Hours: 1
5. Course Description: This course is an introduction to problem solving, decision-making, leadership and helps students become more effective leaders and managers, whether they serve in the military or become leaders in civilian life.
