



Communicable Disease Guidance for CCC Students and Employees –March 6, 2024

General Public Health Guidance for CCC Facilities:

- Hand washing and covering coughs and sneezes are expected hygiene practices
- Do not attend campus if you are experiencing a fever of 100.3 degrees or higher
 - Please utilize CCC's flexible work and attendance policies
- Screen yourself daily for illness and stay at home if you are sick or feeling unwell
- CCC supports routine vaccinations as a way to keep our community safe
- Wear a lanyard with your CCC ID or college-issued name tag when on campus.

Student and Employee Guidance

- It is the responsibility of the individual to follow safety practices that minimize the likelihood that they will miss class or work due to illness or other circumstances.
- Students and employees must work with their instructor or supervisor, in accordance with the CCC policy requirements, to make up any work during an absence from campus.
- Faculty are expected to share their attendance policy and student's ability to meet learning outcomes if required to remain off-campus due to an illness-related absence.

COVID-19 Guidance

Coconino Community College follows the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Center for Disease Control's guidance on public health and safety measures, including COVID-19 protective measures.

If a person is symptomatic and/or is positive for COVID-19 by PCR or Rapid Antigen test, they must remain off CCC facilities until:

- At least 24 hours have passed since the last fever without the use of medicine that reduces fevers, and other symptoms have improved.
- Masks should be worn for 5 days after returning to normal activities
 - COVID-19 rapid tests and masks are available by visiting Security on any campus.
