



## CCC Dual Enrollment Year 2026-2027

Dual Enrollment (DE) refers to high school students who are earning CCC college credit while attending a partner high school in Coconino County. CCC provides a full tuition waiver to county students, therefore saving money and time. High school instructors and curriculum are credentialed by CCC to meet specific college requirements.

### Steps for Dual Enrollment:

1. Inform your high school counselor about your interest in taking a DE course. They will inform you about eligibility and the process.
2. **Important!** Complete the free online CCC admissions application **before September 30<sup>th</sup>**. Choose “Dual Enrollment” for high school students” as your student type. [www.coconino.edu/apply-now](http://www.coconino.edu/apply-now)
3. CCC staff will visit your high school to provide DE information and registration forms to sign. CCC staff will take care of registering students for their course(s).
4. Successfully pass your course with a C or higher in order to earn college credit; your final grade is a permanent record.

***A failing grade or Withdrawal may place you on Academic Suspension.***

If you plan to apply for financial aid to attend college, your financial aid award is based on how successfully you passed your course(s). To remove a failing grade you must retake the course and pass with a C or higher.

Always keep your high school teacher informed about your progress and challenges – you do not want a failing grade.

- **Drop (without record): September 25, 2026**
- **Withdrawal (with W): November 13, 2026**

### **Spring 2027**

- **Drop (without record): February 5, 2027**
- **Withdrawal (with W): April 9, 2027**
