

CCC Dual Enrollment Program, 2025-2026

Welcome! **Dual Enrollment (DE)** refers to students who receive CCC college credit for certain high school courses at participating Coconino County high schools. These courses save students time and money – CCC provides a full tuition waiver to all county students. The high school instructor and curriculum have been credentialed by CCC.

Steps for Dual Enrollment:

- The true first step for participating in DE is to speak to your high school counselor to make sure you are enrolled in the DE course(s) at your high school that are appropriate for you.
- 2. The second step is to complete the free CCC online application for admission. Make sure to choose "Dual Enrollment for high school students" as your student type. Link to application: www.coconino.edu/apply-now
- The third step is registration. CCC will visit your class during the Fall or Spring semester for you to sign a registration form. HS2CCC staff will process that registration form on your behalf.
- 4. The final step is to **SUCESSFULLY** complete the course. For your college credits to count, you need to complete the course with a C or better. Remember you are creating an additional, permanent record of the grade you receive that record is your CCC college transcript.

A grade lower than a C or W can place you on Academic Suspension. If you plan to apply for financial aid to attend college after graduating from high school, your financial aid award is based on how successfully you passed your course(s) with a C or higher. The only way to remove a failing grade is to retake the course and pass with a C or higher. If you have questions, contact CCC Financial Aid staff at 928-226-4219.

Drop and Withdrawal Deadlines:

Fall 2025

- Drop (without record): September 26, 2025
- Withdraw (with W): November 14, 2025

Spring 2026

- Drop (without record): February 6, 2026
- Withdraw (with W): April 10, 2026

What about after high school?

While CCC offers many affordable academic and career programs designed to save students time and money, you do not need to attend CCC after high school for your DE credits to be useful to you. Graduating seniors will eventually need to submit a copy of an official transcript from CCC to their chosen institution of study. For information on ordering your CCC transcripts, visit www.coconino.edu/transcripts
