\*Grand Canyon University will provide the recipient of this scholarship 50% off the catalog tuition rate per course for your program. This scholarship will be applied at the same time the tuition charges occur. While we are pleased to extend this scholarship to you, there are requirements which must be met. In order to remain eligible for this tuition scholarship you must maintain continuous enrollment in your program of study. In an undergraduate program, you must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (minimum 2.0 GPA) throughout your program as indicated in the University Policy Handbook. This is a one-time scholarship and is not transferable to any other student. This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other GCU scholarships. The scholarship will be applied toward your tuition only, and you may not receive this scholarship in excess of your tuition charges on your student account. Average tuition after scholarships is approximately \$8,600. Scholarships may be awarded based on 6th semester transcripts. At the time in which final, official transcripts are received, GCU reserves the right to rescind or modify the scholarship if it is determined that eligibility was not achieved. GCU reserves the right to decline scholarship awards for any reason. If a student does not meet the minimum renewal criteria, their scholarship will be forfeited.
