

Nursing AAS Application Tip Sheet 2024-2025

*Pre-requisites classes for Nursing that must be completed <u>before</u> applying for admission to the Nursing Program include the following.

o ENG 101

BIO 201 (pre-requisite is BIO 181)BIO 202

o ENG 102

o MAT 140 (or higher)

o CHM 130

Prerequisite courses are required to be completed prior to applying to the Nursing Program. For applicants who have a completed Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree, may use that degree to satisfy ENG 101, ENG 102, and MAT 140 only. All other pre- and co-requisites are required as outlined in this document. Official transcripts must be provided to the College once the AAS Nursing degree is declared.

❖ Additional requirements needed <u>before</u> applying for admission to the Nursing Program include:

- o Completion of the Nursing Program Application
- o Grade of "C" or higher in all required pre-requisite courses.
- o <u>Pre-requisite</u> grade point average of 3.0 on a four-point scale or higher.
 - o Although 3.0 is the minimum, successful applicants typically demonstrate a higher GPA.
- o A minimum of 67.1% on TEAS test taken after October 1st for March deadline and after January 1st for June 3rd deadline.
 - o Study guide and resources are available on the <u>ATI website</u>
 - o CCC hosts TEAS testing dates. To register for TEAS testing at CCC, please visit the Nursing Information webpage.
- o AZ LNA license *or* completion of a registered Nursing Assistant Program in the semester immediately preceding the application deadline.
- o The following necessary attachments are required for verification:
 - 1. Unofficial Transcripts from the institutions that granted all pre-requisites
 - This includes CCC unofficial transcripts, and any transcripts from institutions for classes that show as a transfer credit.
 - 2. ATI TEAS Test results
 - 3. LNA License verification from the Arizona Board of Nursing *or* Certificate of Completion from a registered Nursing Assistant Program in the semester immediately preceding the application deadline.

The AAS in Nursing degree includes certain general education courses that are not mandatory prerequisites for admission to the Nursing Program. However, we strongly advise completing these courses before applying, as they can better prepare you for the demanding nature of the Nursing degree. Please meet with your advisor to determine course equivalency for all pre- and co-requisites and what qualifies as an Arts and Humanities Elective.
