Dr. Heiser has been selected to participate in the second cohort of the Aspen Presidents Fellowship, sponsored by JPMorgan


Chase. Dr. Heiser was one of 25 leaders from across the U.S. selected to be part of the cohort. The yearlong fellowship from the Aspen Institute




