



Policy 70-00 Strategic Direction and Planning

Sponsor: District Governing Board

Policy

In collaboration with the College President, the District Governing Board shall adopt, implement, and revise a long-term strategic direction grounded in the College's mission and strategic pillars.

Rather than adopting a fixed multi-year strategic plan, the Board authorizes the President to lead the College through a rolling strategic sprint model. Strategic sprints are time-bound, outcome-driven cycles of work designed to advance the College's strategic direction, respond to emerging conditions, and ensure continuous improvement.

The Board delegates to the President the authority and responsibility to design, implement, and manage strategic sprints aligned to the College's strategic direction and to integrate sprint priorities into institutional planning, budgeting, assessment, and reporting processes.

The Board shall provide oversight by receiving regular updates on progress and outcomes of the strategic sprints and ensuring the President's efforts advance the College's mission and strategic pillars.
