

## **122-06 ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT–PROCEDURE**

### **1. PURPOSE**

The primary purpose of this plan is to ensure that CCC employees, students, and visitors are protected from asbestos hazards, and that applicable asbestos regulatory requirements are followed. It is also intended to provide an accurate database of the location and condition of Asbestos containing materials and to provide a plan on how to manage asbestos.

### **2. PROCEDURE**

This plan applies to all College personnel engaged in the removal, inspection, disturbance, or maintenance of asbestos containing materials (ACM) or presumed asbestos containing materials (PACM) in College facilities. Certain reporting requirements also apply to contracted personnel working in CCC facilities. The plan will ensure that staff, students and visitors are not exposed to asbestos fibers from any asbestos containing materials within the College's buildings.
