207-03 ACCOUNTING, AUDITING, AND FINANCIAL REPORTING-PROCEDURE

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Accounting, Auditing, and Financial Reporting Procedure is to establish criteria and responsibility for financial management practices.

2. PROCEDURE

- The College follows all Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S) regarding Community College District Finances and expenditure reporting. A.R.S. § 41-1279.07 required community college districts of Arizona to prepare an annual budgeted expenditure limitation report and annual financial statements prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.
- 2. Monthly reconciliations of all trial balance accounts are prepared and independently reviewed.
- 3. The College follows all Arizona Revised Statutes regarding tracking and reporting unclaimed property. The College provides a written notice to property holders at least 120 days prior to filing a report of unclaimed property to the State of Arizona.
