



**President's Information Report
May, June, and July 2022**

NOTABLE:

Dean Lisa Blank toured several manufacturing programs as part of the **Arizona Advanced Technology Network (AATN)** which CCC joined this spring. AATN began when Maricopa County Community College, Central Arizona Community College, and Pima Community College partnered to develop a unified, industry-recognized curriculum specifically designed to teach the skills needed for high-paying, high-tech advanced manufacturing jobs. Coconino Community College and Mojave Community College are now part of the consortium and are exploring ways to leverage the partnership in support of local manufacturers such as Gore and Purina.



CCC's application to the **Arizona Community Foundation of Flagstaff (\$105,000.00)** was awarded and will be used to expand CCC's nursing program from one cohort of 30 students/year to two cohorts of 20 students/year and prepare nursing faculty for the NextGEN NCLEX exam that is new this year.

PARTNERSHIPS:

CCC and Habitat for Humanity erected their first tiny home! Students in Key Myers' Spring 2022 Building Methods classes learned about blueprints and framing and then constructed the modular walls that were erected this June as part of the tiny home partnership project.
