NOTABLE

Alexis Knapp Polley and **Kay Leum** attended the American Association of Community Colleges Workforce Development Institute, where CCC was one of 11 institutions recognized at a special luncheon by the Lowe's Foundation.



Spring term started with **Welcome Week** activities designed to reintegrate returning students and welcome newcomers to campus life. Students enjoyed a variety of events, including games, college fairs, and assistance from employee volunteers, all designed to familiarize them with campus resources. The goal was to nurture a sense of belonging, disseminate crucial information, and forge connections among students, faculty, and staff, ensuring a seamless transition into the new academic term.

Full and part-time faculty from various disciplines spent two days learning how to have more active learning in their classrooms. Chandler Gilbert Community College provided the training. The faculty have been using these methods in their classes this semester.



The **CCC Connection Fair** featured a diverse array of organizations, including Trio, EOC, SISS, Tutoring Services, Bridges to Baccalaureate, Phi Theta Kappa, Games Club, Community Outreach, CCC2NAU, LSAMP, ASL Club, Spectrum Alliance, Scholarship Foundations, and more. These organizations provided

valuable resources and opportunities for students, ranging from academic support to social and cultural enrichment. The fair served as a conduit for students to explore various avenues for personal and academic growth, emphasizing the importance of connection within the college community. Student Ambassadors catered to the event creating a welcoming atmosphere for networking and collaboration.



TRIO hosted a Welcome Back Event to kick off the Spring 2024 term. The event aimed to introduce our students to the new TRIO staff members and foster a sense of community. Activities included bracelet making and lunch, allowing students and TRIO staff to engage with each other. Over 40 students and staff members joined the event, making it a successful start to the term.

The **CCC Community Resource Fair** was a comprehensive event connecting students with community resources.
