The Page Indigenous Comet Club and TRIO visited Grand Canyon University. They participated in a campus tour, attended a presentation and Q&A session, and witnessed a college baseball game against Sacramento State.

Throughout the day, our students were guided by enthusiastic GCU students who shared their personal experiences and insights. They explored classrooms, the Lopes Arena, the bookstore, and student dorms. This firsthand experience provided valuable perspectives on both on-campus and off-campus life.

The CCC Indigenous Student Association Club hosted a Spring Craft Bazaar. Five vendors registered and set up to sell their unique handcrafted items including jewelry, blankets, clothing, homemade slippers, skirts, and Easter themed items.





Sarah Benton, American Sign Language faculty, joined Curtis Eddie's Paramedic class and presented on providing care to Deaf and hard of hearing patients during their unit on caring for special populations.



The Maintenance Technician course (CAMT) celebrated its 9th year in March! Five of the six current students took the CAMT (Certified Apartment Maintenance Technician) exam, with a 100% pass rate. In addition, all six students earned additional EPA certifications.

Twelve students will participate in the course, which is being delivered in a hybrid format: three nights each week by Zoom and every other weekend in person in Page with the mobile training unit). The Page course offering is part of ARPA funding received from Coconino County.

The 2024 -2028 Arizona WIOA Title II Adult Education Grant for \$2,084,628 has been submitted. The application will be evaluated by the Arizona Department of Education and reviewed by our local Workforce Development Board, with preliminary Grant Award Notifications being sent in mid-April. The College also applied for \$10,000 through the Dollar General Literacy Foundation, and we'll know by mid-May if the College is an awardee.

PARTNERSHIPS

Student Life hosted a Grab 'n Go event, bringing the Comet Cupboard directly to students. Student ambassadors set up a food distribution table in the Lone Tree Commons. Students could approach the table, provide minimal information, and receive a free bag of grocery items in approximately 30 seconds. 15 bags of groceries were distributed, nearly depleting the Comet Cupboard supply. The Comet Cupboard Grab 'n Go table will be available most Thursdays for students, staff, faculty, and community members.
