A. Identification:

1. Subject Area: Aerospace Studies (AES)
2. Course Number: 202
3. Course Title: Air Power History II
4. Credit Hours: 1
5. Course Description: Establishment of Air Force as a separate service, the Cold War, development of various concepts of employment and technological improvements of air power from Korean conflict to present; effective communication skills. Prerequisites: AES 102 or Consent of Instructor. Students interested in a future career in the Air Force have co-requisites: AES 212 and AES 250 or Consent of Instructor. One lecture.

B. Course Goals: Students will become familiar with key terms and definitions used to describe air and space power. Additionally, they will know the historical events, leaders, and technical developments which surrounded the evolution and employment of USAF air and space power. Students will also know the Air Force Core Values and understand the concepts of professionalism and officership as they apply to the military. Finally, each student will demonstrate basic verbal and written communication skills.

C. Course Outcomes:

Upon successful completion of this course, students will:

1. describe course materials and requirements;
2. describe the basic concepts of effective oral communication;
3. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment of air power from the Vietnam War;
4. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment of rebuilding an Air and Space Force;
5. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment from the Persian Gulf War;
6. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment from USAF Operations post Cold War;
7. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment from the conflict in the Former Republic of Yugoslavia;
8. cite selected historical events, leaders, and milestones in the technical development and deployment from the Global War on Terrorism: Ops EF & IF;
9. and present an oral communication, which demonstrates effective delivery, organization, and expression.
