The Arizona Democratic Party is seeking highly motivated Field Organizers to join our Statewide Organizing Team. Field Organizers will serve as representatives of the Arizona Democratic Party in their communities and will play a vital role in building Democratic infrastructure across the state.

Key Responsibilities:

- Be the lead in your region for voter registration efforts, enrolling voters in Vote-By-Mail, engaging communities around local issues and elections, and other outreach activities as directed.
- Recruit and train volunteers who are vital to the success and infrastructure of local and county parties across Arizona.
- Coordinate local and county events (virtually and in-person) to educate voters and grow the membership of local and county Democratic parties.
- Build relationships and engage with community organizations and local stakeholders on behalf of the Arizona Democratic Party in your assigned region.
- Leverage digital tools to motivate, recruit, and train volunteers and voters.
- Provide support to assigned county parties and local Democratic organizations as needed.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Previous formal campaign experience is not required, AZ experience is strongly preferred.
- A commitment to the Democratic Party in Arizona and eagerness to elect Democrats statewide.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to engage with people from diverse backgrounds.
- Solutions-oriented, creative, and flexible. Every day as an organizer will look different, and it's important that organizers have a positive attitude and are ready to be team players and find creative solutions to ensure we meet our program's goals.
- Have access to a vehicle and driver's license; ability to relocate as necessary.

 - *Overtime is paid at 1 1/2 times the hourly rate after 40 hours*
- Benefits: Eligible for UnitedHealthcare Medical, Dental, Vision plan at no premium.

- Hours: 55 hours/week
- This is a union role with IBEW representing organizers.
- Organizers will report directly to the ADP Organizing Director.
