

CCC Course Placement Criteria: 2018-2019

English Placement by Accuplacer & ACT/SAT

CCC Students take both Reading Comprehension and WritePlacer for ENG placement (can transfer in Sentence skills and Reading Comprehension for placement, but CCC does not administer Sentence Skills)
 Students who score 210-236 on the Next Gen Reading or 30-40 on the Accuplacer Reading or 1-2 on WritePlacer must take ENG 095.
 *Students who place into ENG 095 should **NOT** take any other reading and/or writing class until they complete ENG 095.

Testing Tips:

- students need to be admitted to CCC to placement test for CCC (we can proctor them for another school if needed for a fee at the Lone Tree campus only – Please note that Page can **NOT** proctor students for other schools)
- first test is free and they can retake once in the same semester at a cost of \$12 per section (math, reading or writing)
- students should bring photo ID, COMET ID number and arrive 15 minutes prior to start of testing
- no calculator or dictionaries are allowed (some math questions provide a calculator to students)
